








OUR SOLAR SYSTEM (Güneş Sistemimiz)



This is our solar system. The Sun is the brightest object in it. It reflects its lights to the planets and the stars. There are eight planets in it. They all orbit around the Sun. There is also Pluto in our solar system but the scientists don't call it a planet anymore since 2006. They call it dwarf planet.

Our planet, the Earth is the third planet from the Sun. It is the only planet that has the living forms on it. It has a satellite called "Moon". It orbits around the Earth and they both orbit around the Sun.

- As a result of moon's orbitting around the Earth, days occur.
- As a result of Earth's orbitting around the Sun, seasons occur.



The truths about the Solar System;

- The gravity of the Sun pulls the planets to itself.







Characteristics of the planets in the Solar system.

MERCURY

It is also known as the swift planet. It is the smallest, hottest and the closest planet to the Sun in the solar system. The temperature on Mercury is $450\,^{\circ}C$ on normal days but nights are freezing cold. Mercury is the fastest planet in the solar system.

VENUS

Venus is also called as a morning star, is the second closest planet to the Sun in the solar system. Venus completes one complete revolution around Sun in 255 earth days. On bright days, Venus is visible through the naked eye because it is also one of the brightest planets.

EARTH

The third planet in the solar system is the solar system is the only planet in the whole universe which can sustain life. Its nickname is blue planet. It completes one revolution around the Sun in 365 earth days. The presence of water and oxygen is what makes earth sustain life.

MARS

It is also known as the red planet and the fourth planet from the Sun. Mars completes one full revolution around the Sun in 687 earth days. It is most likely to be the next home for human beings after the Earth.

JUPITER

Its nick name is giant planet. It is known the biggest planet. It completes one revolution in 4333 earth days. It has 79 natural satellites revolving around it.

SATURN

It is known as the ringed planet, because of the rings around it. It completes one revolution in 10759 earth days. It has 62 natural satellites composed of ice.

URANUS

It is the second largest planet in the solar system. It completes one revolution in 30687 earth days. It is also the coldest planet in the solar system.

NEPTUNE

The last planet in the line is Neptune also called a big blue planet. It is 2.8 bilion miles away from the Sun and takes 60190 earth days to complete one revolution.




